Sorry for the late reply, there is just too much urgent work coming in...

Thank you for your e-mail and letter with regard to your objection to AMMR becoming an ICAR Member Organization.

Your objection was forwarded to the ICAR membership application work group and was then also looked at by the entire ICAR Executive Board upon its last recent meeting. All of us can understand your viewpoints.

The application documentation we received from AMMR doesn't directly violate any of our membership conditions/requirements, which is why we cannot just reject it. We also looked at the aspect that single persons cannot become an ICAR Member Organization with votes. The application documents from AMMR do say that AMMR has 10 doctors, 4 nurses and 3 office workers as active members in its organization. Dan F. Hourihan (Assessor in the ICAR Executive Board and member of the ICAR membership application work group) will seek personal contact with Kazue and representatives of your delegations during our convention in Chamonix in order to further clarify the issue.

Nevertheless the AMMR membership application will be on the agenda of this year's ICAR Assembly of Delegates (Agenda/Invitation to the ICAR Assembly of Delegates requires to be online on our website on September 19) together with your objection. In the end, the ICAR Assembly of Delegates is the only organizational body in ICAR which can take a final decision on ICAR memberships (as lined out in our bylaws).

Regarding JSMM and ICAR Membership, there is this history to it: JSMM submitted via Kazue an ICAR membership application in 2016 (some documentation was missing, some documentation was in Japanese only). We then asked for this missing documents and for English translations. However we never received that in 2016 or 2017. In April 2018, Kazue informed us, that the Board of JSMM had decided not to follow up on its 2016 ICAR membership application and not to join ICAR as a member organization. Following that Kazue then sent us the ICAR membership application for AMMR.

I hope this helps to clarify the current situation and our proceedings.
