on April 23rd, 2020 "BOCOM - Experience Borderless Communication" was scheduled to take place as an innovative test lab and multi-site congress. The central conference location with about 200 experts in Berlin, connected with decentralized hubs around the globe - and all participants working interactively and participatively on the communication and collaboration of the future. We still believe in this concept wholeheartedly! However, due to the current dynamic development in connection with the spread of the corona virus, we have now decided, in close cooperation with our partners, to postpone BOCOM.

Making this decision was not easy for us, but the safety and health of all BOCOM partners, participants and speakers is our top priority. We do not know how long this exceptional situation is going to last for, but at this time we cannot approach BOCOM with the attention it deserves.

The project is funded by the German Federal Environmental Foundation and scientifically accompanied by the Fraunhofer IAO. The main goal of this research project is to investigate the concept of a hybrid event, i.e. to compare aspects of the online event with live aspects of this event and to derive recommendations. This research would not be feasible with a pure online event and therefore we decided against this option.

We are already looking forward to getting BOCOM rolling with you on its new date, September 3rd, 2020! We are convinced: Together we will overcome this crisis and launch into the future of the event sphere with many fresh ideas.
