Workshop description

The proposed workshop is to enable to experts, between the IKAR – CISA Organization to get together and exchange and form opinions, best practices, discuss and reach common grounds on issues of common interest. As a result of such workshops the findings presented before the various IKAR Commissions assemblies and disseminated to the members will carry a consensus.

The results of such a workshop will be disseminated at a later stage to larger publics (IKAR members, rescue teams, etc). The funding of this workshop can and will be obtain through the Life Long Learning Program (Grundtvig Workshops)



- Candidate Organizations (organizers)
 - Any organization capable to demonstrate skills of organizing efficiently such a workshop
- Candidate Participants
 - Any person older than 18 years old
- Who can benefit from this
 - The workshop organizer and its members
 - Adults from any EU country member



- Workshop duration can be up to 10 days
- The number of participants can't exceed 20 people and the 1/3 of the participants can come from the organizing country
- Funding can cover travelling and accommodation expenses for participants who will apply to the organizer who will cover all their expenses

Strengthen relations between IKAR members

Best practices know-how and experience sharing

Develop useful material to be distributed to **IKAR** members regularly

Minimize costs for research and development of training material between IKAR members



Proposal by CSAR

- In addition to the annual congress that is organized once a year, 6 workshops (bi-monthly basis) can be organized in order to prepare material that will be distributed to IKAR members prior to each year's congress
- The initiative of workshop organizing can be undertaken by IKAR – CISA members or in coordination/cooperation with the respective commissions (Terrestrial, Avalanche, etc)
- The material-reports that will be the result of these workshops will be distributed to IKAR CISA members prior to each year's congress and can be used for discussion, thus enabling members to reach easier consensus on these matters.
