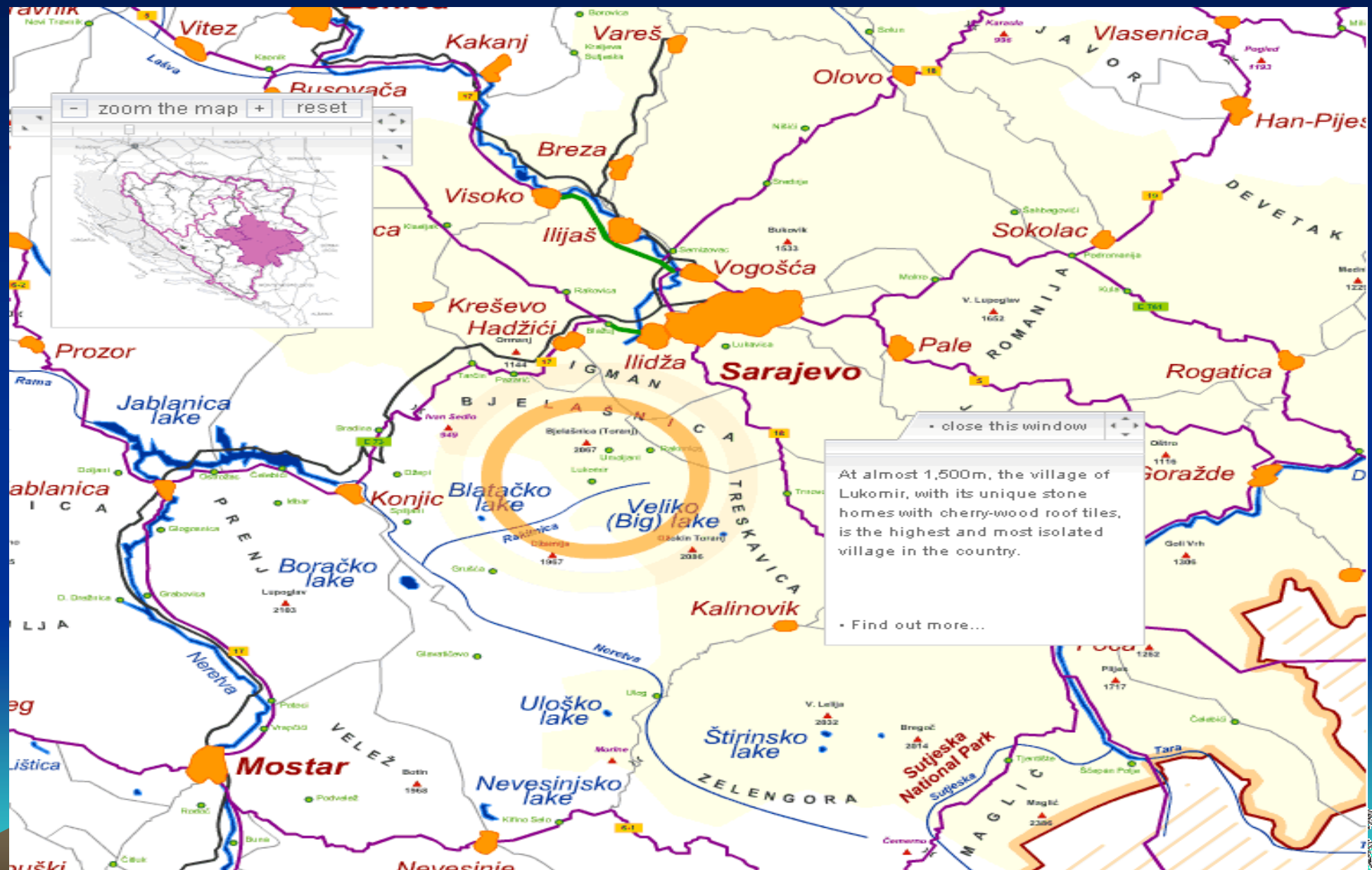

Village of Lukomir, Bjelašnica Bosnia and Hercegovina

- 13 families
- 30 inhabitants
- 5 younger men (under 45 years)
- 3 younger women
- 3 children, two aged 3 and 6, one 7 months old
- 19 others are over 60 years of age
- The eldest man is 85 years old

Medical and other supplies

- Medicaments (antihypertensives, cardiotonics, antibiotics-for adults and for children, analgesics, antipyretics, antirheumatic creams, vitamins)
- Diapers for adults
- Fresh fruits (apples, oranges, lemons)
- Bandage materials
