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

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Medical treatment in the mountain environment is different to that in other rescue operations

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1. ORGANIZATION ASPECTS (1)

- Integration of mountain rescue services into state/regional/local emergency medical systems
- »Time is life« in emergency medicine
- »The doctor to the site of the accident as soon as possible«.

1. ORGANIZATION ASPECTS (2)

 work under extreme conditions..."








Doctor's rucksack

all the time


Advantages:

 Main disadvantage:
- expensive









3. PROFESSIONAL SKILLS / PROCEDURES

- Diagnostic procedures: status, RR, core temperature, ECG, oximetry, capnometry, etc....
- Therapeutic procedures: resuscitation if necessary, RSI, oxygen delivery, analgesia, sedation, fluid resuscitation, symptomatic therapy, cardiac pacing, immobilisation, etc...
