
HGSS-CMRS

- National, voluntary, non-profit organization
- Operates in the name of the Republic of Croatiapublic authority
- Part of civil protection
- 1150 members, 25 teams/stations
- 800+ missions per year
- Legally responsible for all non urban SAR
 - Mountains, caves, rivers, canyons
 - Search missions, helicopter rescue, ...
 - "disasters and all situations in which usage of specialized skills and equipment is required for preservation of human life" HGSS Act.

- 28/12/2020, 06:28 local, 05:28 UTC
- 5,2 Richter magnitude scale
- 29/12/2020, 12:19 local, 11:19 UTC
- 6,2 Richter magnitude scale





Facts

- App. 105 000 inhabitants in the area
- 272 villages
- 58 000 damaged buildings
- 13 000 uninhabitable buildings
- 15 000 people in need of shelter
- 4,8 billion € damage
 - 12 billion € in Zagreb EQ 2020
- 7 deaths
- 30+ injured



Mobilisation Deployment

- K9 training in progress
- In first 5-10' no comms
- Coordination with civil protection
- CMRS base in Sisak destroyed
- Immediate mobilisation of whole CMRS
 - All teams informed-whatsup, telegram, ...
 - Lack of informations
 - Experience from march 2020-Zagreb EQ


Mobilisation Deployment


- CP/BOO 1345 local E entrance to Petrinja
 - Establish ICS "search management"
 - Focus-unfocus / tunelvision
 - It is not 1 incident or mission late
- Arrival of resources
 - 286 members from 23 teams available at 1330 local
 - 192 from 13 teams "accepted"
 - 45 members, 2 K9 2 helicopters
 - 45 vehicles
 - 13 K9 on the field
 - 24-48-72 hours



Operations-BOO


- 10-15 people in ICS structure






Problems/chalenges

Typical Phases of Disaster






Summary 29/12/2020-12/02/2021

- 42 796 working hours
- 2920 members
- 2650 interventions
 - 1942 "general help" 42 per day
 - Support for ambulance, logistics, medical supply, reconnaissance
 - 682 rope access -14 per day
 - 11 rescue 6 under rubble
 - 15 medical emergencies
